is filled with stories about outdoor adventures, missionary endeavors, children confronting peer pressure, and Bible stories. Issued quarterly in braille. (Ages 9–12)



The Adult Bible Study Guide

is a daily Bible study guide providing in-depth Bible lessons for personal Christian growth. Issued quarterly on mp3 disc (English and Spanish editions). Issued monthly in braille (English).



Light

provides a Christian perspective on topics such as personal relationships, disabilities, health, and other issues. Issued bimonthly in large print.

Vantage Point

includes interviews and inspirational articles on a wide range of subjects, including health and fitness, nature, travel, music and the arts, and stories of personal accomplishment. *Vantage Point* seeks to discover Bible-centered spiritual connections among the many experiences of life. 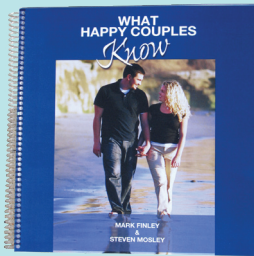
Encounter

is a Spanish-language magazine that brings a Christian perspective to problems people face today. Topics include health, family living, the Bible, and current events. Issued quarterly on mp3 audio disc.



Free Booklets

in English braille and large print (English and Spanish) inform and inspire on a variety of topics. Write for a listing and descriptions.

Full-Vision Books

offer character-building stories in a combination of braille and print. They enable blind parents to read to their sighted children and sighted parents to read along with blind children who are learning braille.



INSIGHT4VETS

offers solar digital audio players loaded with a collection of books that were chosen in consultation with veterans and chaplains to improve the quality of life for veterans who are blind.



Lending Library

More than 1,500 books are available to United States clients on digital cartridge and in braille through the CRSB library. An online library with streaming services and Daisy download is also available at Lib.Guide.

Bible Courses and Gift Bibles

Bible courses in English are available on digital audio cartridge, in braille, and in large print. Gift Bibles are available to U.S. residents.
